Ancillary services such as routine lab work and ultrasounds can be performed at the facility of your preference. Acute or urgent care needs are managed through SVMC.

Before her certification as a midwife she worked as the nurse manager in labor and delivery at a local hospital. Office visits consist of a schedule of routine prenatal visits as well as urgent visits if the need should arise. The guideline for routine prenatal visits is as follows. Every 4 weeks for the first 28 weeks of pregnancy, every 2 weeks until 36 weeks and then weekly visits beginning at 36 weeks gestation. Your family members are welcome to come with you to your visits.

Appointments are made during our office hours, Monday through Friday 9am until 4pm. We ask that if you are unable to keep an appointment to please call to cancel/ reschedule. Please confirm we have your current phone number on file at each visit to ensure we are able to reach you.
